Who is the course for?

This course is essential for NGOs operating in conflict zones and high crime area particularly for humanitarian aid workers and Journalists, or potential aid workers who are planning to work in the field or regularly visit disaster areas. It is also a very good introduction for senior managers and decision makers in order to enable them to take informed decision concerning staff and organisation safety and security.

- Understand the roles and responsibilities
- Applying vulnerability & risk assessment tools and techniques
- Exploring options for security strategies
- Dealing with check points
- Dealing with gunfire, grenades and shelling
- Surviving kidnapping and abductions

Completing the course

By completing this course, participants will be able to describe why good security management is essential for maintaining effective aid programme; identify the main hazards, threats and risks facing them as individuals or as organisations; discuss different options of security strategies and learn to apply some safety and security skills.

Learning Methodology

It will encourage participants to think creatively and will utilise contemporary adult learning methodologies including: interactive lectures, group work, classroom exercises, activities, work sheet, mapping, discussion, presentations, case studies, video show, games and brain-storming.
